Regulations on English Course Enrollment and Waiver

1. The term “English courses” in these Regulations refers to College English (1), (2), (3), and (4) offered by the Committee of General Studies, as well as College English (5) and (6) offered by the English Taught Program in International Business. These six courses are to be taken over six semesters. College English (1) through (4) have prerequisites, meaning they must be taken and passed in sequence before progressing to the next course.
2. Students of the Program who have taken English proficiency tests such as TOEIC, IELTS, or TOEFL before enrollment or during their studies and have achieved a minimum score of TOEIC 800, IELTS 6.0, or TOEFL 78 may apply for a waiver of College English (1) through (6). However, the waived courses must be substituted with one of the following:
 - University-wide elective foreign language courses offered by the Language Center,
 - Advanced English courses,
 - Foreign language courses offered by other departments at Shih Chien University,
 - Intercollegiate foreign language courses,
 - EMI (English-Medium Instruction) courses offered by any department, or
 - Relevant professional foreign language courses taken at partner institutions abroad.
3. The validity period of English proficiency test score reports is limited to a maximum of four years.
4. Applications for course waivers must be submitted during the first week of the semester in which the waiver is sought.
